MOBILE HOUSEHOLD WASTE AND RECYCLING CENTRE

Despite Poynton Town Council opposing the closure of the HWRC, Cheshire East Council have not listened to our concerns and have now closed the centre.

The mobile household waste and recycling site will be based off **Anson Road, Poynton, SK12 1TD (on part of the HWRC site that is now under an emergency closure.)** The mobile HWRC is available from Saturday 10 August. This is the first weekend after the emergency closures.

The Town Council continues to oppose the charges and are making strong representations to Cheshire East about the detrimental effect this will have on the Town and local residents. The charges will not apply to the short-stay section of the car park, which is leased to Waitrose.

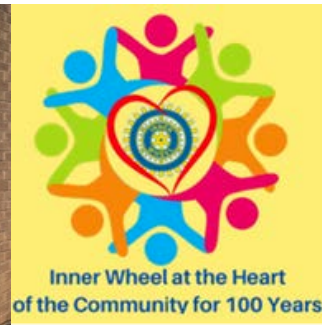
Poynton Town Councillors are still in dialogue with Cheshire East Car Parking regarding their plans to introduce charges to the long stay section of the Civic Centre car park.

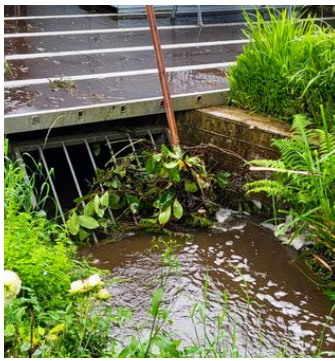
INNER WHEEL DONATE BLEED CONTROL KIT

Inner Wheel have generously donated a bleed control kit to Poynton Town Council which will be placed in the defibrillator cabinet located at Poynton Civic Hall. This is in support of The Daniel Baird Charity which aims to raise awareness of the importance of having publicly accessible bleeding control kits. The kits can be used to administer vital first aid to control a catastrophic bleed until medical services arrive and can be accessed by the emergency services on 999/112.

FLOOD GROUP REQUEST



Poynton Town Council monitor and where appropriate, clear the trash barriers and culverts of both Park Lane stream and Poynton brook. Residents are kindly reminded to ensure waste garden materials such as cut branches/logs don't enter water courses, as this causes blockages and increases the potential for surface water flooding at times of high rainfall.
